Trinity's mission statement is one of action. It is faithful to the traditions of the Episcopal Church. The statement is visionary, offering parishioners a place and way to serve. Service, whether within the parish or as outreach to the larger community, is fundamentally rooted in worship, teaching and service.

To accomplish Trinity's mission, a structure of commissions is in place. The word "commission" is a synonym for "mission," and Trinity's commission structure has eight commissions designed to accomplish God's mission.

What is a commission? At Trinity, it is a group of people dedicated to a particular area of concern or service and headed by a chairperson, with a Vestry member assigned as a liaison to the Vestry. Many parishioners serve on one or more commissions. Some are not permanent members of any commission but are tapped from time to time to assist with the work of a commission.

In August, each commission chair submits a proposed budget request to the Budget Committee. The framework of the operating budget, designated and approved by the Vestry, is framed according to the structure of the eight commissions.

Every aspect of parish ministry falls under one of eight commissions. Everyone is invited and encouraged to be a part of at least one commission.
